

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The application priority date for summer financial aid is **April 1, 2009**. Please allow a minimum of two weeks from the time of registration for processing. You will be notified of your summer eligibility.

Academic progress is measured after the Spring 2009 term. If you fail to meet the Financial Aid Office academic progress standards, you may not be eligible to receive financial aid for the 2009-2010 Academic Year. However, you may be eligible to receive financial aid for Summer.

Summer Session applicants must have the 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file. The deadline for filing the 2008-2009 FAFSA is June 30, 2009. The FAFSA can be completed online at: www.fafsa.ed.gov

If you make adjustments to your hours or type of aid requested, adjustments will not be processed until registration can be confirmed.

2. SESSION DATES

Summer budgets are based on actual dates of attendance. **Periods of non attendance will not be covered by financial aid.** If you apply for financial aid or register for classes after May 1, 2009, you will be responsible for paying tuition and fees. Financial aid may subsequently be awarded if eligibility is established.

3. AVAILABLE AID

a. Part-time Federal Work-Study will be awarded to eligible undergraduate students who are enrolled for at least 3 credit hours during the summer 2009 session. All financial aid awards are subject to available funding.

b. Full-time Federal Work-Study employment will be awarded to eligible undergraduate students who are NOT enrolled during the summer 2009 session and who are enrolled for at least 6 credit hours for the Fall 2009 semester. A portion of full-time FWS earnings will be used to meet your financial need for the 2009-2010 Academic Year. **Indicate on this application whether you would like to be assigned to an Off-Campus job or an On-Campus job (Morgantown campus).**

c. Federal Pell Grant awards are potentially available during the summer for students who did not utilize their full award during the 2008-2009 Academic Year. The amount is based on the number of hours for which you are enrolled on the last day of add/drop.

d. Federal Direct Parent Loans (PLUS) are available to parents of dependent students. If a parent would like to be considered for this loan, indicate that on the *Request for Summer 2009 Financial Aid* and complete a PLUS application, which can be downloaded at: www.finaid.wvu.edu

e. Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loans are available to Graduate students. If you would like to be considered for this loan, indicate that on the *Request for Summer 2009 Financial Aid* and complete a Graduate PLUS application, which can be downloaded at: www.finaid.wvu.edu

f. Federal Direct Loan awards are based on the number of credit hours for which you enroll and your grade level as well as remaining eligibility from 2008-2009 Academic Year. See the chart in the next column.

g. Alternative Loans are available in the event you used your yearly Direct Loan maximum in the Academic Year. Please refer to our web site at www.finaid.wvu.edu

NOTE: You will not be able to delay Summer 2009 payment based on anticipated Fall 2009 financial aid.

NOTE: Undergraduate students must register for at least 6 credit hours to be considered for Federal Direct Student Loans and/or Federal Parent Loans. Graduate students must register for 3 credit hours to be considered for Federal Direct Student Loans and Graduate PLUS Loans. If you drop to less than 6 hours for Undergraduates, or less than 3 hours for Graduates after aid has been disbursed, aid will be canceled and you will owe a repayment to WVU. Financial aid will not be released until the student begins attendance in the minimum number of credit hours. This may result in delayed release of financial aid payments and funds to students for living expenses. For example, an Undergraduate who takes a 3 hour class which starts on May 31 and takes another 3 hour class which starts on July 15 will not receive a disbursement of loan funds until July 15.

4. TRANSIENT STUDENTS/STUDY ABROAD

Failure to provide complete information on the Summer application will result in a delay in processing. Note that you are responsible for paying the other school's charges according to that school's due date.

If you are a WVU student taking part or all of your summer credit at another college, you must contact the WVU Financial Aid Office. A copy of your Transient Agreement from your academic advisor and a signed Consortium Agreement from the other school are required before your aid will be processed and released. If you are a student from another college taking transient hours at WVU, you must contact your home school to apply for financial aid.

5. VETERANS EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS

Using Veterans Educational Benefits/Montgomery GI Bill may result in a reduction of eligibility for Financial Aid.

If you are receiving Chapter 1606, Chapter 1607, or Chapter 30 Montgomery GI Bill; Chapter 31 Veterans Vocational Rehabilitation; or Chapter 35 Veterans Educational Benefits for Survivors' and Dependents', please indicate that on the *Request for Summer 2009 Financial Aid*.
