

2010-2011 FINANCIAL AID TIMELINE

To explore your financial aid options before December, go to www.FAFSA4caster.ed.gov.

December 2009

- 2010-2011 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) paper applications arrive at high schools and colleges.
- Apply for your Federal Student Aid PIN at www.pin.ed.gov. The PIN can be used to electronically sign your FAFSA on the Web and complete your Master Promissory Notes (MPN) for federal educational loans. You and your parent(s) should apply for separate PINs.

January 2010

- You can begin submitting (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. To receive consideration for all aid programs, your FAFSA must be received by the federal processor by March 1, 2010. If your application is received after March 1, 2010, you will only receive consideration for Federal Pell Grants, Academic Competiveness Grants (ACG), National Science & Mathematics Access to Retain Talent (SMART) Grant and Federal Direct Loans. If you are interested in any state or private aid programs, check with the agency for application and deadline information.

March 2010

- WVU Financial Aid Offices begins to send award notifications to applicants who met the March 1st deadline. You will receive an award notification detailing how you accept/decline the financial aid offers from WVU.

June 2010

- First-time Direct Loan borrowers complete:
 - Online Master Promissory Note (MPN) at <https://dlenote.ed.gov>
 - Online Entrance Counseling at www.dl.ed.gov

July 2010

- Award notifications are mailed to students who qualify for West Virginia or Pennsylvania State Grant programs by the state's higher education agency.
- Approximately one month prior to the beginning of each term, students will be notified about their account status by MIX email from the Office of Student Accounts.

August 2010

- Payment is due on Saturday before the start of the fall term August 21, 2010.
- Classes begin August 23, 2010! Welcome to WVU!
- Financial aid for fall term is released to your student account. Funds will first be applied to any WVU charges.
- If you are awarded Federal Work Study, you must pick up your Work Study Assignment at the Financial Aid Office within the first 21 days of classes.

January 2011

- Time to start the financial aid process again at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
