FACT SHEET

Requirements/Qualifications

- Any student who has performed over 100 hours of service or service learning between January and December 2009 is eligible.
- There are three different age brackets: Kids- up to 14, Young Adults- 15-25, and Adults- 25 and up.
- The hours can be accumulated through volunteerism or service learning.

Award Levels

- The awards will be given on three levels:
 - **Bronze**- 100 to 174 hours
 - **Silver**- 175 to 249 hours
 - **Gold**- 250 or more hours
- The honoree will receive only one award (the highest bracket for which they qualify).

Nominations

- Nominations can come from anyone, whether faculty, staff or students. A person can also self-nominate for the award.
- All nominations are due by January 25, 2010.
